All Other Business

Proposals for next season's programme and expanding venues:

Chair encouraged Fellows to share their knowledge and experience noting that it is a responsibility of fellows to contribute

The facilitated discussion of issues raised by members to be held 2025 Increased focus to support members who seek to become chartered – especially mentioning the Incorporated Engineers as an intermediate grade. Promote Registration to students.

Marcus Graney raised concerns with dilution of speakers between the. Division CPD programme, Auckland Branch, and University of Auckland / RAeS monthly Seminar. Marcus suggested that each

program promote each other. Roger Warren, mentioned that the Branch presenter pipeline is currently filled for the next year.

Shaun Johnson suggested that in lieu of a monthly lecture an alternate a social function be run to attract an alternate population. Following on, a suggestion from the floor was that lectures/functions be run at a later time, say 1930, to overcome traffic, geographic bottlenecks. Venues:

Air New Zealand is happy to help with the use of their premises in the city, Mangere. and Airport (flight sim) which have streaming facilities. (It is noted that the train station at Puhunui has a connection to the Airport via the orange buses).

Student representatives mentioned that in general students do not have vehicles so their preference is the Grey Lynn, and preferably University venues. Students prefer week ends, and public holidays for event. In addition, during the Nov -Feb break students are not available to attend events.

Look into streaming at the Grey Lynn site to suit off-site presenters.

Mike Flanagan suggested a consolidation of the industry bodies.

Mike recommended a committed member on the branch to act as a liaison with the other bodies such as Aviation Industry Association, Airports Association, Aerospace Auckland etc, along with involvement with academia. Noting that this is also a function that the NZ Division would normally lead, but the Auckland Branch can initiate the process to spread the burden with the NZ Division.
